### Artwork specifications:

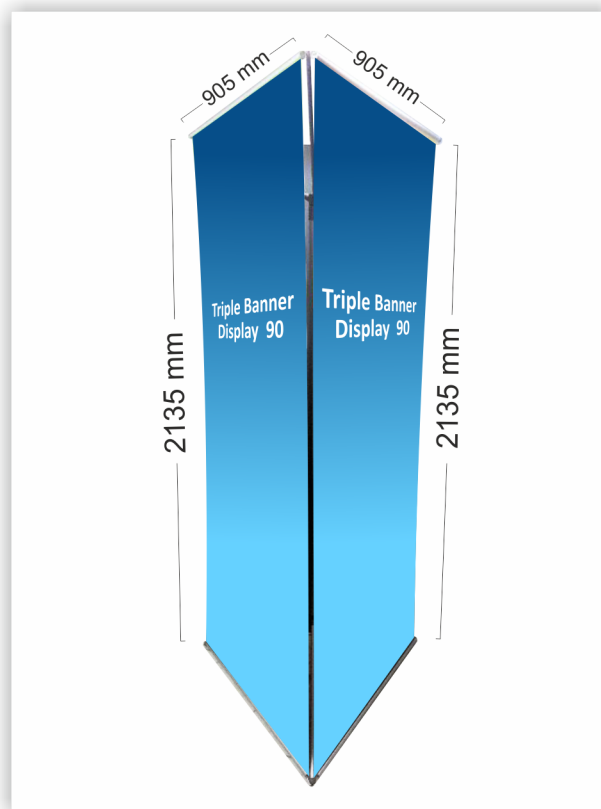
- ✓ file format: TIFF, JPG, PDF, CDR, EPS, PSD, AI - we recommend TIFF
- ✓ color mode: RGB, CMYK or a combination of RGB, CMYK, Pantone (only in PDF or AI files)
- ✓ the artwork should be build as one file, without bleed / trimming marks
- ✓ scale 1:1
- ✓ resolution: minimum 72 dpi - we recommend 150 dpi
- ✓ all Corel Draw files must have fonts converted to outlines.
- ✓ we recommend using LZW compression when exporting TIFF files.

### Product specifications:

- ✓ total graphic area: W: 905 mm H: 2175 mm
- ✓ visible graphic area: W: 905 mm H: 2135 mm

### Recommendations:

- ✓ Do not place important graphic elements (logo, texts, images, etc.) in the following areas:
  - last 20 mm to the bottom and last 20 mm to the top, which may get into the case (see the next page template)
  - close to the edge of the visible area.
- ✓ The graphic colors may slightly differ from the colors on your screen or on other print proofs, due to factors such as: type of the printed material, ink type, print technology, your screen calibration, etc. If in doubt, we recommend you to request a print proof, prior to placing an order.
